**REGULAR MEETING WEST HANCOCK BOARD OF DIRECTORS
October 19, 2020**

Motion by Eekhoff seconded by Burgardt, to approve the items listed under the consent agenda. Carried: 4-0

The CTE staff was here to present the programs to the board.

Administrative reports were given.

Motion by Burgardt, seconded by Deutsch, to approve the volunteer coaches list: Doug Doughan, Dave Brown, Ethan Kronemann, Seth Goepel, Paul Francis, Jeremy Barns, Dale Hesley and Jordan Savoy for the 2020-2021 winter sports. Carried 5-0

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Iowa Code Sections 257.18-257.21 an instructional support program is available to all Iowa school districts, and,

WHEREAS, the West Hancock Community School District Board of Directors believes it is in the best interest of the school district to continue to participate in the instructional support program, and,

WHEREAS, the West Hancock Community School District has held a public hearing on the continued participation of the District in the instructional support program and taken into account public input,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Board of Directors of the West Hancock Community School District announces its intent to continue to participate in the instructional support program.
2. The Board also hereby answers the following proposition in the affirmative:
Shall the Board of Directors of the West Hancock Community School District in the Counties of Hancock, Wright and Kossuth, State of Iowa, be authorized for a period of five years commencing with the 2021-22 budget year, to levy and impose an instructional support tax in an amount (after taking into consideration instructional support state aid) not to exceed ten (10) percent of the total of regular program district cost for the budget year and monies received under Section 257.14 as a budget adjustment for the budget year, and be authorized annually, as determined by the board, to levy a combination of an instructional support property tax upon all the taxable property within the school district, commencing with the levy for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, and to impose an instructional support income surtax upon the state individual income tax of each individual income taxpayer resident in the school district on December 31 for each calendar year commencing with calendar year 2021, or each year thereafter, (the percent of income surtax not to exceed twenty percent (20%) to be determined by the board for each fiscal year) to be used for technology, educational program improvements or any general fund purpose?
3. If, within 28 days following the adoption of this Resolution, the Secretary of the Board does not receive a petition seeking an election to approve or disapprove the action of the Board containing signatures of eligible electors in a number of not less than 100 or 30% of the number of voters at the last preceding regular school election, whichever is greater, the Board shall immediately certify its action to the Department of Management and the District shall participate in the program.
4. If a petition with the requisite number of signatures as aforementioned is received, the Board shall consider whether to rescind its action or direct the County Commissioner of Elections to submit the question to the registered voters of the school district at the following regular school election or a special election. At the election, if a majority of those voting on the question favor disapproval, the Board shall not participate in the instructional support program and if a majority of those voting on the question favor approval, the Board shall immediately certify the results of the election to the Department of Management and the District shall participate in the instructional support program.

RESOLUTION PROPOSING TRANSFER OF REAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the West Hancock Community School District proposes to transfer real property consisting of an approximate 2 acre parcel without buildings to Kimberly Dolphin by

quit claim deed in exchange for the sum of \$40,000. The parcel is legally described as follows: Parcel A located in Lot 4 of Auditor's Plat of Section 33, Township 96 North, Range 25 West in the City of Britt, Hancock, Iowa. The transfer is contingent upon a zoning change to allow commercial use.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY RESOLVED, that a hearing shall be held on the proposed transfer and following hearing, final action on the transfer shall be considered and voted on at a School Board meeting which will be held on the 16th day of November, 2020, at 6 o'clock p.m. at the Board Room West Hancock Community School District High school, Britt, Iowa.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the School Board Secretary is hereby directed to publish notice of hearing on the proposal to transfer the above described property not less than ten nor more than twenty days prior to the hearing in accordance with Section 297.22 of the Code of Iowa.
